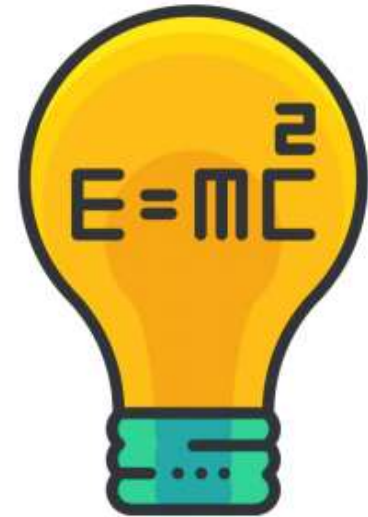

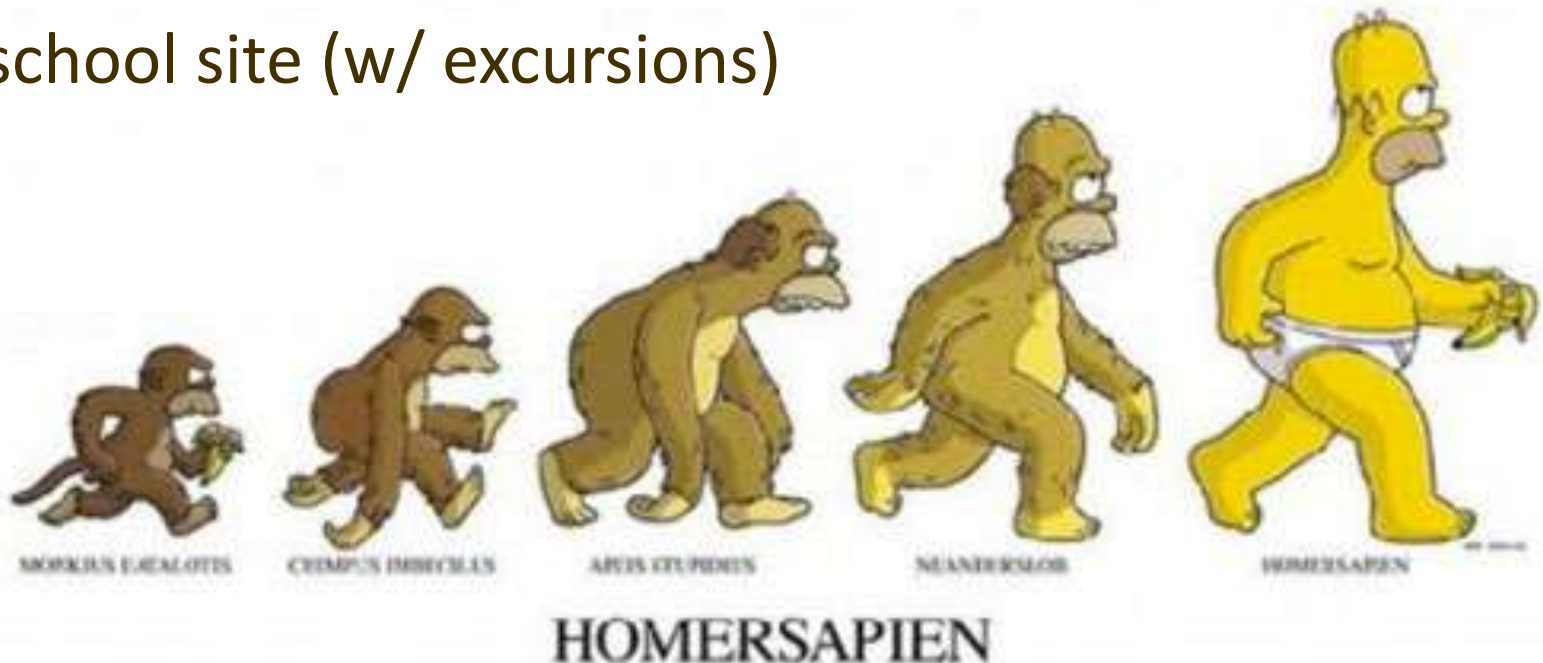

- CTE & Office of Secondary Schools

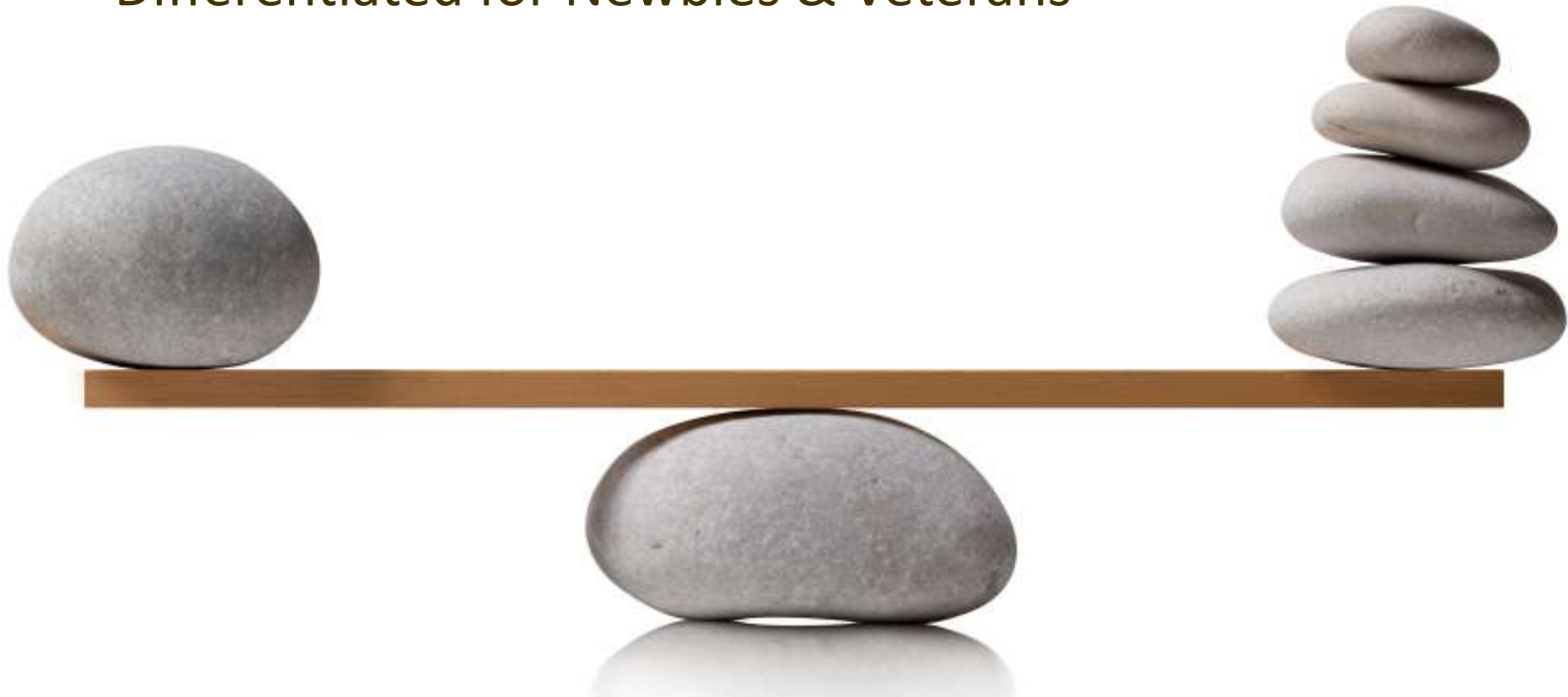

- Differentiated for Newbies & Veterans




Day 1: Design Thinking on the Midway

- Learn from Others in District
- Build Industry Connections

What is the follow up from PBL Institute?



Challenges

- Summer school and other obligations
- New teams need more individualized support
- Master scheduling and teaming changes
- More guidance for newer teachers + more “experts”
- Varying “cultures” of support at sites
- If a team member loses connection



Solutions or Ideas

- New teams need more individualized support
 - PBL Scholars
 - Encouraging Admin Participation
 - Drawing on Experts in the Room
- Summer school and other obligations
 - Alternate Times / Opportunities
- Master scheduling and teaming changes
- Varying “cultures” of support at sites
- If a team member loses connection
 - Supporting admin with strategies to champion and help teachers sustain the work
