THE FINISH LINE
















Students complete all UC-CSU college entrance requirements. Students participate in over 200 hours of work-based learning experiences.

Students complete 60 units of college credit in their Ag Pathway. Associate of Science degree in Agriculture the summer after high school graduation.




THE FIRST COHORT – CLASS OF 2018






SNAPSHOT: A-G COMPLETION RATES






SNAPSHOT: COLLEGE COMPLETION







3. CASE MANAGEMENT

stay on track.








3. CASE MANAGEMENT
